Sub: Incentivise and encourage ITI pass-out to join Indian Army as Agniveers under Agnipath Scheme – reg

Sir/Madam,

As you may be aware that the Union Cabinet has approved an attractive recruitment scheme for Indian youth to serve in the Armed Forces. The scheme is called 'AGNIPATH' and the youth selected under this scheme will be known as 'Agniveers'. AGNIPATH allows youth to serve in the Armed Forces for an initial period of four years.

A special provision has been made by the government to incentivise and encourage ITIs pass-out as eligible candidates to join as Agniveers in the Tech category. The following bonus marks are allotted to the ITI qualified-

- (a) 30 Marks for one-year course from Govt. of India recognized ITI.
- (b) 40 Marks for two-years courses Govt. of India recognized ITI.
- (c) 50 Marks for Diploma holder.

In view of above, you are requested to kindly communicate the above said decisions of Ministry of Defence to the current trainees as well as alumnus of ITIs. It will provide an opportunity to ITIs pass-out to avail this employment opportunity.
